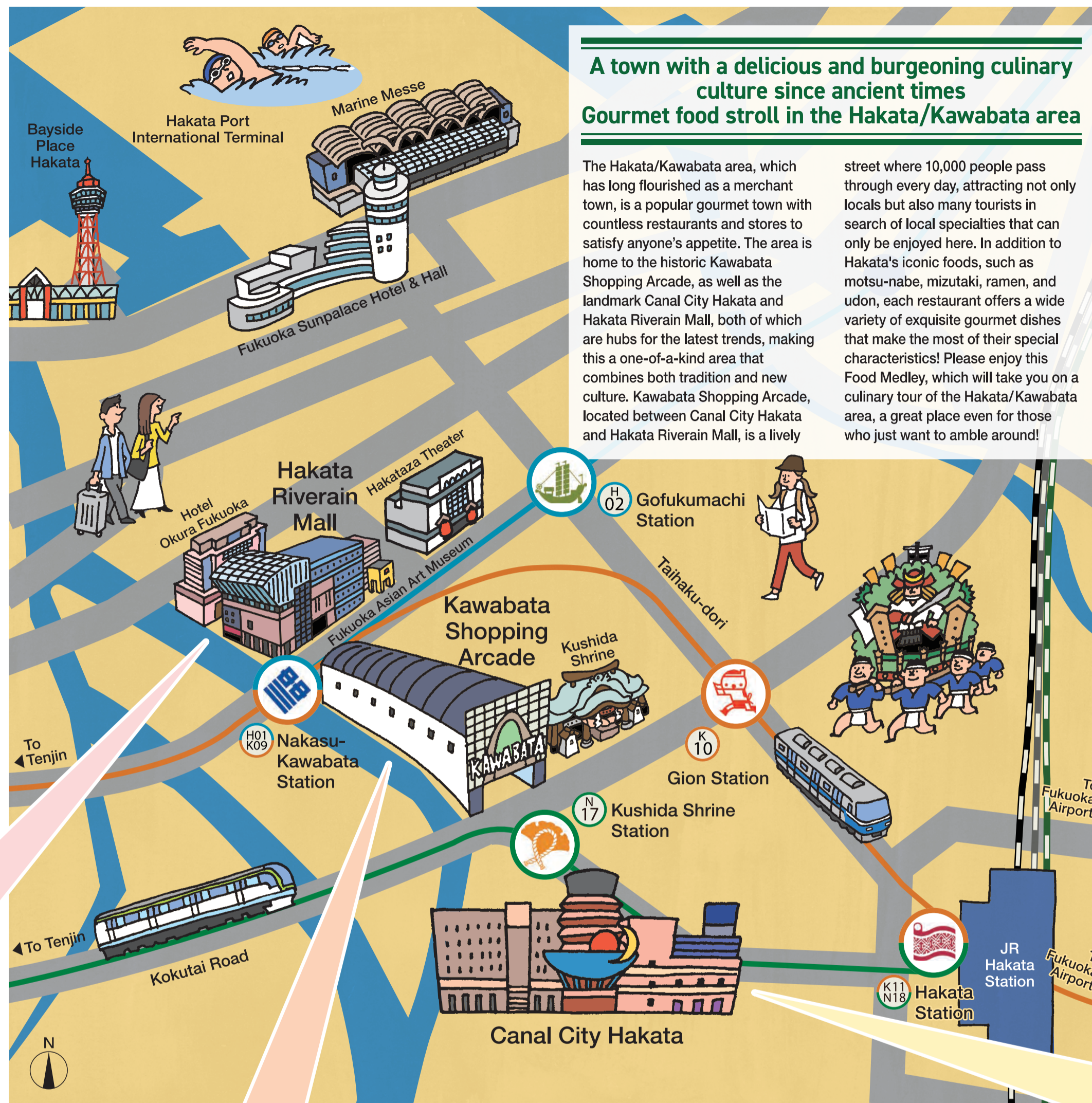

In addition to Hakata's iconic foods, such as motsu-nabe, mizutaki, ramen, and udon, each restaurant offers a wide variety of exquisite gourmet dishes that make the most of their special characteristics! Kawabata Shopping Arcade

Kawabata Zenzai Square

Zenzai is a traditional Japanese dessert made from red beans. Kawabata Zenzai was a popular local dish for much of the 20th century. The store serving this dish subsequently closed down, but the shopping arcade took the initiative to reopen it. In addition to regular zenzai, you can also enjoy zenzai served with ice in summer! Many festival-related items are on display, including a huge decorative Yamakasa float.

Kushida Shrine

Famous across Japan as the dedicated shrine of the Hakata Gion Yamakasa Festival, held in July, Kushida Shrine also holds the Setsubun Festival in February, and the Hakata Okunchi Festival in October. Known among locals as O-Kushida-san, it is the grand tutelary shrine of Hakata.



Kawakami Otojiro

Actor born in Hakata. He became famous during the Meiji period (1868-1912) for his satirical comic stories and plays, especially his song Oppekepe Bushi. Having established a new kind of theater called *shosei shibai*, he laid the foundations for new schools of drama. Later, he and his wife Sada Yacco led a troupe that toured throughout Europe to great acclaim. He can be considered a pioneer in the modernization of Japanese theater.

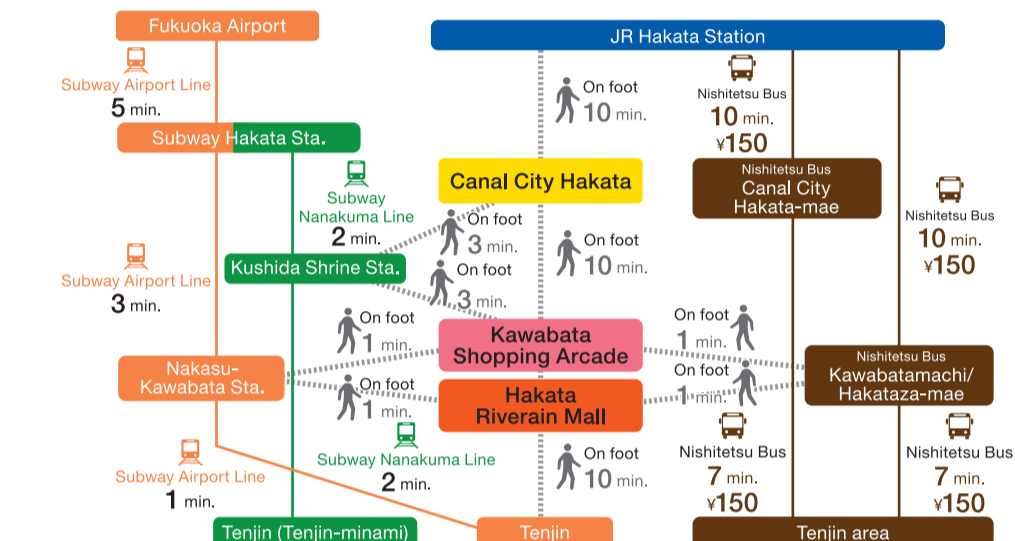
